Marshall Mutual Insurance Company

The mutual insurance concept was developed by Benjamin Franklin with the first mutual insurance company named the Philadelphia Contributorship. The concept was that a group of people would come together to help each other in the event of a loss by fire. In the event of a fire the members of the group would make the individual whole again by dividing the cost of the loss among themselves. This was called an assessment. You paid a fee to join the group. There were no premiums as we know them. They divided the losses, but you never knew what your costs would be.

Marshall Mutual is one of the oldest continuous business operators in Clark County. On March 18, 1889, a group of farmers met at the Blackhawk School in Darwin Township to provide protection against fire and lightning, a new peril, in Darwin, Anderson, and Wabash Townships.

The first board of directors were S. D. Coldren, president, O. O. Taubeneck, secretary, Samuel Rudy, F. W. Stump, A. Shumaker, Martin Kittle, William Kerran, J. J. Meehling, and Fred Bubeck. The charter members and other officers through the years are on a separate list included at the end of this paper.

The Darwin Township Mutual Fire Insurance Company had a very humble beginning as the board did not have any money to begin with. The board borrowed \$60.00 from H. E. Taubeneck to pay for the state charter and forms to begin operation.

The first claim paid by the new company was paid on August 12, 1889, to Fred Lencht who was the holder of policy # 57. The claim was for a cow killed by lightning, and a total of \$15.00 was paid.

On December 30, 1889, the books of the Darwin Township Mutual Fire Insurance Company showed an income for the year of \$212.75 with expenses of \$169.22. The company had 72 policies on the books with \$62,190 of insurance in force.

On February 18, 1891, the company held its first meeting in Marshall at the courthouse. With the 1891 meeting the charter was changed and the name became Marshall Mutual County Fire Insurance Company. With this change they could write

insurance in every township in the county instead of just Darwin, Anderson, and Wabash.

From 1891 to 1953 the company operated as a county mutual only writing insurance in Clark County. In 1953 the area was expanded to Edgar, Coles, and Cumberland Counties. In 1956 Crawford and Jasper Counties were added. In 1987 the name was changed from Marshall Mutual County Fire Insurance Company to Marshall Mutual Insurance. The name was changed because it implied a restriction to Clark County at a time when we were expanding to other counties.

Today we can write in 31 counties in the state and have agent offices in 13 towns with 21 agents. We have expanded from the original perils of fire and lightning to "all risk". We still operate under a board of directors and the original mutual concept that the policy holders own the company. Today we charge a premium for coverage and do not use assessments. We have a series of reinsurance companies in place to protect the policy holders against an assessment.

In 1993 we had a severe hail storm that came through Marshall. That one 5 to 10 minute storm cost Marshall Mutual 1.7 million dollars. That year we paid out \$2,431,271.00 and no assessment plus no rate increase.

We have come a long way from a board that had to borrow \$60.00.

Jackie Titus started working for Marshall Mutual insurance in February 1968, just one year out of high school.

Frank Pearce was secretary-treasurer at that time, and Gene Pearce was an agent. Harry Murphy, whose great grandson Jeff is a partner of Shore-Murphy Insurance, was president of the board.

The company office was located on North 6th Street, where Marshall Realty is now located.

In those days, Jackie worked as receptionist and bookkeeper. All the records were kept by hand. She was paid \$1.60 per hour.

In the 1970s she was named assistant treasurer, a title which she held for over 30 years.

Through the years, as the company grew, she continued to work as the main bookkeeper with everything computerized.

Jackie will retire at the end of January. She says that she won't miss all the work, but she'll really miss her co-workers. Jackie will be back to visit and has agreed to work one day at the end of each month to help with the end-of-the-month record keeping.

Judie Nave started to work with Marshall Mutual and Shore-Parker Insurance 23 years ago.

Marshall Mutual had purchased the former Duane Bank location at 6th and Ar-

cher and was in the process of remodeling it at that time.

In the late 1980s Marshall Mutual merged with two other mutuals.

In her early years, they hand-rated the policies. In recent years, all of that is done by computer.

In 2002 when Dick Parker retired, Judie came in as a partner, along with Jeff Murphy and Kathy Haskins. Later that year, they started Shore-Murphy & Associates of Casey.

With Judie's retirement, Wendy Tharp will be coming

in as a partner.

"I'll really miss working with our policy holders," said Mrs. Nave. "I've made many friends and appreciate all who have been loyal insureds."

At the present time, in addition to Dwight Shore, Kathy Haskins and Wendy Tharp and Jeff Murphy, the personnel consist of Laura Tingley and Jan Torgerson - office staff with Shore-Murphy and Marshall Mutual and Katie Titus, Colleen Gard, Brent Kile and John James-Marshall Mutual.





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
