ORDINANCE NO. 2015-O- 11

AN ORDINANCE ADDING CHAPTER 70, STREETS, SIDEWALKS AND OTHER PUBLIC PLACES. ARTICLE II. EXCAVATIONS. DIVISION 2. PERMIT. SECTION 70-81. COMPLIANCE REQUIREMENTS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Marshall, Illinois:

Section 1. That Chapter 70 of the Code of Ordinances, City of Marshall, Illinois is hereby amended by adding a new section, 70-81. Compliance Requirements, to read as follows, with strikeouts indicating deletions in text and underscores indicating additions to text:

Sec. 70-81. Compliance Requirements.

In addition to the filing of the application and the furnishing of a performance guarantee and insurance, the applicant shall have followed all rules of the JULIE System and Illinois law and shall have accomplished all of the following to the satisfaction of the Director of Public works or his or her authorized representative before the permit is approved by the Director and before proceeding with the actual work:

- A. Submit a dimensional drawing to be attached to the permit, showing the location and details of the proposed work horizontally and vertically.
- B. Manually excavate and expose every buried facility to be crossed or within ten feet horizontally of the proposed route of the work. Notify the Director of Public Works after the exposures and 24 hours (weekday) before the permit may be approved before the work may begin.
- C. Where Horizontal Directional Drilling (HDD) is used, a tracking device must be used to continually identify the horizontal and vertical location of the drilling head.

Section 2. If any provision of this Ordinance, or application thereof, is held invalid by any Court, other provisions or applications of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application shall not be affected, and to this end the provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form and shall take effect ten (10) days after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
