AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING GARBAGE

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Marshall, Illinois:

Section 1. That section 38-47 of the Code of Ordinances, City of Marshall, Illinois is hereby amended to read as follows, with strikeouts indicating deletions in text and underscores indicating additions to text:

Sec. 38-47. Garbage.

No person shall deposit or place any offal, garbage, manure, or any kind of refuse, animal or vegetable matter in any alley, street, yard, or in any public or private grounds in the city, but the same shall be placed in watertight receptacles, which shall be kept in some convenient and secure place on the premises, to be removed as often as may be necessary to prevent the formation of noxious gases or offensive odors. It shall be the duty of the owner, occupant or agent to clean the premises or street or alley wherein such refuse has been deposited, at his own expense. Any officer of the city shall notify such owner, occupant or agent to clean the premises or streets or alleys bordering on their premises, and if such owner, occupant or agent shall fail to clean such premises, streets or alleys within twenty-four hours ~~five days~~ after service of such notice, then such owner, occupant or agent shall be deemed guilty of creating and maintaining a nuisance and in violation of this article.


Section 2. If any provision of this Ordinance, or application thereof, is held invalid by any Court, other provisions or applications of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application shall not be affected, and to this end the provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form and shall take effect ten (10) days after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
