ORDINANCE NO. 2011-O- 13

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING STREET OBSTRUCTIONS

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Marshall, Illinois:

Section 1. That section 70-9 of the Code of Ordinances, City of Marshall, Illinois is hereby amended to read as follows, with strikeouts indicating deletions in text and underscores indicating additions to text:

**Sec. 70-9. Obstructing street.**

- (a) It shall be unlawful to deposit on any street any material which may be harmful to the pavement, or any waste material, ~~or any grass clippings, or to cause a lawnmower to blow grass clippings onto a street,~~ or any other articles such as glass which may cause injury to any person, animal or property.
- (b) No person shall place or cause to be placed or erected on any public ground, or in any public street, alley or sidewalk in the city, any debris, materials or obstruction, except as may be permitted by this Code.
- (c) It shall be the duty of the police department to exercise a vigilant supervision over the places mentioned in this section and to notify any person found making such deposit or responsible for such deposit to remove the offending matter at once.
- (d) It shall be unlawful to deposit any grass clippings, or to cause a lawnmower to blow grass clippings on any curb and guttered street that has a catch basin or storm water outlet.

Section 2. If any provision of this Ordinance, or application thereof, is held invalid by any Court, other provisions or applications of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application shall not be affected, and to this end the provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form and shall take effect ten (10) days after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
