AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING WARD BOUNDARIES

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Marshall, Illinois:

Section 1. That section 34-31 of the Code of Ordinances, City of Marshall, Illinois is hereby amended to read as follows, with strikeouts indicating deletions in text and underscores indicating additions to text:

Sec. 34-31. Boundaries.

- (a) *Ward No. 1.* Ward No. 1 shall consist of all that territory in the city lying generally north and east of a line commencing on Sixth Street (Clarksville Road) northwest of the city limits; thence southeasterly on Sixth Street (Clarksville Road) to Cypress Street; thence east on Cypress Street to Seventh Street; thence north on Seventh Street to Oak Street; thence east on Oak Street to Eighth Street; thence south on Eighth Street to Mulberry Street; thence continue southeasterly on Eighth Street to the intersection of North Michigan Avenue (Illinois State Route 1) and Archer Avenue; thence north on North Michigan Avenue (Illinois State Route 1) to Plum Street; thence northeasterly on Plum Street to Fourteenth Street; thence northwesterly on Fourteenth Street to Beech Street; thence from the centerline of Fourteenth Street northeasterly along the extension of the north line of Beech Street 370 feet; thence southeasterly 640 feet to Archer Avenue; thence northeasterly on Archer Avenue (East National Road) to Illinois State Route 40; thence easterly on Illinois State Route 40, at Archer Avenue; thence north on Seventh Street to Cypress Street; thence west on Cypress Street to Sixth Street (Clarksville Road); thence northwest on Sixth Street (Clarksville Road) and lying north of Archer Avenue.
- (b) *Ward No. 2.* Ward No. 2 shall consist of all that territory in the city lying generally west and south of a line commencing on Sixth Street (Clarksville Road) northwest of the city limits; thence southeasterly on Sixth Street (Clarksville Road) to Cypress Street; thence east on Cypress Street to Seventh Street; thence north on Seventh Street to Oak Street; thence east on Oak Street to Eighth Street; thence south on Eighth Street to Mulberry Street; thence continue southeasterly on Eighth Street to the intersection of North Michigan Avenue (Illinois State Route 1) and Archer Avenue; thence southwesterly on Archer Avenue (East National Road), at Archer Avenue; thence north on Seventh Street to Cypress Street; thence west on Cypress Street to Sixth Street (Clarksville Road); thence northwest on Sixth Street (Clarksville Road) and lying north of Archer Avenue.
- (c) *Ward No. 3.* Ward No. 3 shall consist of all that territory in the city lying generally east of a line commencing on Vine Street east of the city limits; thence west on Vine Street to South Michigan Avenue; thence northwesterly on South Michigan Avenue to Illinois State Route 1; thence northwesterly on South Sixth Street to Archer Avenue; thence northeasterly on Archer Avenue to North Michigan Avenue (Illinois State Route 1); thence north on North Michigan Avenue (Illinois State Route 1) to Plum Street; thence northeasterly on Plum Street

to Fourteenth Street; thence northwesterly on Fourteenth Street to Beech Street; thence from the centerline of Fourteenth Street northeasterly along the extension of the north line of Beech Street 370 feet; thence southeasterly 640 feet to Archer Avenue; thence northeasterly on Archer Avenue (East National Road) to Illinois State Route 40; thence easterly on Illinois State Route 40, east of Sixth Street and south of Archer Avenue.

- (d) Ward No. 4. Ward No. 4 shall consist of all that territory in the city lying generally south of a line commencing on Vine Street east of the city limits; thence west on Vine Street to South Michigan Avenue; thence northwesterly on South Michigan Avenue to Illinois State Route 1; thence northwesterly on South Sixth Street to Archer Avenue; thence southwesterly on Archer Avenue (East National Road), west of Sixth Street and south of Archer Avenue.

Section 2. If any provision of this Ordinance, or application thereof, is held invalid by any Court, other provisions or applications of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application shall not be affected, and to this end the provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form and shall take effect ten (10) days after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
