AN ORDINANCE REZONING THE PATSY SIMPSON PROPERTY

WHEREAS, pursuant to sworn Petition for Change of Zoning executed Patsy Simpson and pursuant to Notice of Hearing published at least fifteen (15) days nor more than thirty (30) days before the date of hearing, the Zoning Commission held a public hearing; and

WHEREAS, no written objections were filed to the Petition; and

WHEREAS, the zoning commission has recommended that the Petition for Change of Zoning be allowed; and

WHEREAS, it appears that the property hereinafter described is currently zoned R-1 and that the public interest will be subserved by rezoning the property to R-4; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has approved said Petition by majority vote.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARSHALL;

Lot Two (2) in Block Twenty One (21) in William B. Archer's First Addition to the Town (Now City) of Marshall, Clark County, Illinois  
The above described property index number is 08-08-13-15-403-016

and located at 1301 Ash Street, Marshall, Illinois, be rezoned from R-1 to R-4 and that the zoning map referred to in Article III, Section 2 of Appendix A of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Marshall be and the same is hereby amended accordingly.

That this Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form and shall take effect ten (10) days after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
