ORDINANCE NO. 2012 -O- 16

An ordinance amending the text of Chapter 1, General Provision Section 1.10 Minor Violations Penalty to read as follows:

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Marshall, Illinois:

Section 1. That section 1.10 of the Code of Ordinances, City of Marshall, Illinois is hereby amended to read as follows, with strikeouts indicating deletions in text and underscores indicating additions to text:

(1) Any person accused of a violation of any section of this Code may, after receiving a ticket under this section and prior to such person being issued a formal complaint or notice to appear, settle and compromise the claim by paying to the city, through the police department, the sum of ~~\$25.00~~ \$50.00 on or before 14 days from the issuance of the ticket or by paying to the city, through the police department, the sum of ~~\$50.00~~ \$100.00 subsequent to said 14-day period.

(2) Tickets issued under this section shall be as a courtesy in lieu of arrest. If the person accused of the violation does not settle the claim, a complaint or notice to appear ~~shall~~ may be issued for that violation and the person ~~shall~~ may be subject to the penalties set forth in section 1-5 of this Code. The city is under no obligation to issue a ticket under this section as a courtesy in lieu of a formal complaint or notice to appear.

Section 2. If any provision of this Ordinance, or application thereof, is held invalid by any Court, other provisions or applications of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application shall not be affected, and to this end the provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form and shall take effect ten (10) days after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
