RESOLUTION TO TERMINATE PARTICIPATION BY ELECTED OFFICIALS IN THE ILLINOIS MUNICIPAL RETIREMENT FUND

WHEREAS, the City of Marshall is a participant in the Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund:

WHEREAS, elected officials with the City of Marshall may participate in the Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund if they are in positions normally requiring performance of duty for 600 hours or more per year; and

WHEREAS, this governing body can determine what the normal annual hourly requirements of its elected officials are, and should make such determination for the guidance and direction of the Board of Trustees of the Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund; and

WHEREAS, this governing body has previously determined that the elected position of Alderman required performance of duty for at least 600 hours per year: and

WHEREAS, the duties and responsibilities of this position have changed and it no longer requires performance of duty for at least 600 hours per year, effective November 1, 2012.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Marshall, Clark County, Illinois finds that the position of Alderman no longer qualifies for IMRF participation as of November 1, 2012.
