What is the Residential Landscape Award?

This Award recognizes the hard work and pride exhibited by Marshall Residents because we are proud to have a community that strives to beautify their homes, neighborhoods and the City of Marshall. This Award was created to recognize Marshall Residents who have improved and maintained the exterior landscaping of their homes. The Award is intended to inspire others to take pride in their home, improve their landscaping, pick-up litter and to improve the quality of life in the City of Marshall.

What are the evaluation criteria?

The evaluation criteria are based on five categories:

1. Consistent maintenance
2. Tasteful and creative landscaping
3. Lawn accents
4. Good use of seasonal color
5. Overall appearance.

How do I nominate a yard?

You may nominate a yard by filling out a Residential Landscaping Award Nomination Application. This application can be found on the City of Marshall's official website or can be picked up at the City of Marshall City Hall.

Who are the judges?

Judging is completed by the City of Marshall's Park Committee.

How are the winners announced?

The Park Committee will announce the 4 winners during the 2nd City Council meeting in June. Each winner will receive a decorative yard sign designating that their yard is a winner along with a check for \$50.00. A photograph of the winners and their yards will be placed in the local newspaper along with the City of Marshall website and Facebook page.
