The Marshall Police Department is seeking applicants for the position of full time Police Officer.

Lateral Hire and Entry Level Hire will be considered. Applicants must be a US citizen, a minimum of 21 years old, a High School Graduate or equivalent (GED), possess a valid driver's license and pass a background investigation, pre-employment Drug Screen and Oral Interview. Applicants who are not currently Illinois State Certified Police Officers will also be required to pass the Illinois Police Officer P.O.W.E.R. test, written test and physical.
